#### **SPECIAL NOTICE - INVASIVE SPECIES**

Invasive species from around the globe threaten Greenwood Lake as well as many other bodies of water. The Greenwood Lake Commission is working to eradicate Eurasian Water milfoil in our waters and leads a community wide effort to stop new invasive species before they can get a stranglehold on the lake. The participation of every citizen is needed to prevent the destructive consequences of invasive species.

**Please, before launching your boat in Greenwood Lake and when leaving:**

- INSPECT** Thoroughly inspect all boat and trailer parts for marine growth
- REMOVE** Remove all visible plant, animal material and mud
- DRAIN** Pull boat plug, drain all bilge water and livewells before launch
- DISCARD** Discard bait buckets/material away from lake
- RINSE** If possible, rinse all boat parts, trailers and equipment with water. Use **HOT** water when possible (above 140°) to ensure plant and animal growth is removed. If hot water is not available, use tap water.

**Inspecting your boat for Aquatic Invasive Species is REQUIRED by LAW and appreciated to ensure the waters of Greenwood Lake are protected now and for future generations.**
